Historical Context

1977	OMB published Race and Ethnic Standards for Federal Statistics and Administrative Reporting
1994	OMB published a note of proposed review and possible revision
1997	OMB published Standards for Maintaining, Collecting, and Presenting Federal Data on Race and Ethnicity
2014	OMB established the Interagency Working Group for Research

on Race and Ethnicity (Working Group)



Background and Review Process

Research Agenda Includes:

- 1. Questionnaire Format and Nonresponse
- 2. Classification of Middle Eastern or North African Race/Ethnicity
- 3. Additional Minimum Reporting Categories for American Indian or Alaska Native, Asian, Black or African American, Hispanic or Latino, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander, and White Groups
- 4. Relevance of Terminology



Background and Review Process

Schedule of Standards' Review

September 30, 2016

OMB published a Notice to signal review and possible limited revision (30-day comment period)

March 1, 2017

OMB published a Notice indicating research proposals + the Working Group published its Interim Report (60-day comment period)

Late-Spring Early-Summer

Working Group working toward making final recommendations

Late-Summer Working Group submits Final Report with recommendations

to OMB

December 1, 2017

OMB publishes final decisions and new standards, potentially
