Government Spending Per Resident


2022 Minneapolis Budget spending per resident by department.


Local Tax Spending on Each Activity:

- Courtesy of Civilities
- General Fund: revenues to the state from taxes, fees, interest, to be used to operate government activities.



Housing Burden:

- Housing is the largest expense for families and individuals
- Amount of folks nationally has gone up since 2000 (from 39 to 49 percent overall)



Commute Time:

- Long commute times
 linked to low levels of
 health; both physical and
 mental
- People of color are getting pushed out of cities due to increasing housing costs
